Community Outreach, Food 4 Neighbors – Vera and Andrea

- Work in the community and Sandburg is one of the schools supported in the Ft Hunt area
- It's all volunteer run
- About 7 years in this Ft Hunt area supported (6 schools)
- They look at the free and reduced lunch program for needed middle and high schools
- 2,700lbs of food collected at last event
- Families can sign up to fill up their provided red bags with a list of needed items attached and all collection dates
- The need seems to be growing every year
- The goal is to assist the schools help the kids that need it
- Those able to help have the option of giving money as another option which are turned into gift cards for families
- Also collect toiletries and feminine hygiene products

- Refer to school social worker if anyone comes across someone or family in need or if they know families interested in helping out with the efforts in some way
- January 11th is next collection event
- Accept kids 9 -13 years of age (they just need to come with adult) to assist with volunteering

Mr. Eric Underhill's School Update

- Honor Roll Recognition this year will be after school with families on 2 separate nights for 7th and 8th graders instead of during the day
- New theater teacher had an improv night last week
- 25 student female leaders represented CSMS at Dr Jill Biden's "Girls Leading Change" Event which the students met the 9 nominees and toured the White House; CSMS brought the largest group at the White House
- Cross country season has ended; top finishes in both boys and girls at the championship meet
- Attendance is a big focus; this year we're at 10.4% which is a great number
- iExcel being used for personalized Math, Science, and Reading support if needed for 20 min a day
- Students of the month; about 70 students nominated for this month
- 8th grade parents' promotion dates are June 9 (2 houses), June 10 (2 houses), June 11 (1 house); only in the mornings
- 2 New primary sponsors of National Junior Honor Society; will expand opportunities to students with both Winter and Spring inductions
- Hosting some of the county job fairs; one will be this Saturday
- 6 Outstanding Staff of the Year announced today
- Students are doing a very good job and thank the parents for their assistance
- Students have been filling out "Thank You" cards during this Thanksgiving Season; will make banners out of them to hang up around school
- Talked with muralist(s) along with student leadership group on how to get positive messages around the school and will use some of the stairwells; will put together fundraiser signups for this multi-year effort
